

BENEFICIAL USE OF SPOIL

This form is to be filled out for any project that uses the spoil material in a beneficial manner. For the purpose of this form, the beneficial use of spoil is defined as the placement of dredged/spray dredged or excavated spoil material in such a manner so as to cause the possibility of creating, restoring, enhancing and/or protecting wetland habitat. One of the things it doesn't include is the placement of spoil material in an open-water, high-energy environment where the spoil material will likely not remain in place for any foreseeable amount of time.

CUPNO - is the permit number the beneficial use occurs under.

APPLICANTS NAME - name of the applicant.

BENEFIT TYPE - this is taken from the Mitigation Types For Database hand-out. See Support Services for the most up-to-date printing.

PARISH - name of the parish where the beneficial use occurs.

ACRES CREATED - this is the total acres of spoil placement that has been deemed to be of a beneficial nature.
